1. Cookie Policy

We respect the privacy of visitors using https://riyadh-cables.com/ and associated sites or pages (our "websites"). This cookie policy provides you with clear and comprehensive information about the cookies we use and the purposes for using them.

Our websites use cookies, in combination with pixels, local storage objects, and similar devices (collectively, "cookies" unless otherwise noted) to distinguish you from other users of the website.

You do not need to allow cookies to visit most of the websites. However, enabling cookies may allow for a more tailored browsing experience and is required for certain parts of the website to work. In the majority of cases, a cookie does not provide us with any of your personal information.

2. What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer. When you visit our site, strictly necessary cookies will be placed on your device. You can change the cookie settings that will be placed when you visit our website by changing the settings on your browser or by visiting the Cookie Preference Centre by clicking on the Cookie button at the bottom of this policy.

3. Key Concepts

First and third-party cookies: whether a cookie is 'first' or 'third' party refers to the domain placing the cookie. First-party cookies are those set by a website that is being visited by the user at the time (e.g. cookies placed by https://rivadh-cables.com/).

Third-party cookies are cookies that are set by a domain other than that of the website being visited by the user. If a user visits a website and another entity sets a cookie through that website, this would be a third-party cookie.

Persistent cookies: these cookies remain on a user's device for the period specified in the cookie. They are activated each time that the user visits the website that created that particular cookie.

Session cookies: these cookies allow website operators to link the actions of a user during a browser session. A browser session starts when a user opens the browser window and finishes when they close the browser window. Session cookies are created temporarily. Once you close the browser, all session cookies are deleted.

4. How to delete and block our cookies

You can change your cookie preferences when you visit our website by going to the Cookie Preference Centre by clicking on the Cookie button at the bottom of this policy. You can also block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the

setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including strictly necessary Cookies), you may not be able to access all or parts of our site.

5. Change your cookie settings

Please note that internet browsers allow you to change your cookie settings. These settings are usually found in the 'options' or 'preferences' menu of your internet browser. - Select the Privacy panel
- o To enable cookies: Check 'Accept cookies for sites'
- To disable cookies: Uncheck 'Accept cookies for sites'
- o Note there are various levels of cookie enablement and disablement in Firefox.

• Cookie settings in Chrome

- Click the wrench icon on the browser toolbar
- Select Settings
- Click 'Show advanced settings'
- o In the "Privacy" section, click the 'Content settings' button
- To enable cookies in the "Cookies" section, select 'Allow local data to be set', this
 will enable both first-party and third-party cookies. To allow only first-party cookies
 select 'Block all third-party cookies without exception'
- To disable cookies, in the "Cookies" section, select 'Block sites from setting any data'
- o Note there are various levels of cookie enablement and disablement in Chrome.

Cookie settings in Safari

- o Click on 'Safari' at the menu bar and select the 'Preferences' option
- Click on 'Security'
- To enable cookies: In the 'Accept cookies' section select 'Only from site you navigate to'
- To disable cookies: In the 'Accept cookies' section select 'Never'

7. How do our Sites use Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies?

Riyadh Cables Group (RCG) uses cookies and other tracking technologies across its websites to improve their performance and enhance your user experience. At times we may seek to place a cookie on your device (for instance, your computer's hard drive) which allows the server to recognise the device when it visits again, in order to track statistical information about navigation to and throughout certain areas of our website. The information that is tracked by such a cookie is used only for internal purposes, such as to improve website navigation and to measure the effectiveness of our promotional placements. For example, we keep track of the domains from which people visit and we also measure visitor activity on the website, but in a manner that would keep the information anonymous.

To administer our Sites and for research purposes, RCG also has contracted with third-party service providers to track and analyse statistical usage and volume information from our Site users. These third-party service providers use persistent Cookies to help us to improve the user experience, manage our Site content, and analyse how users navigate and utilize the Sites.
